Chapel Rental: \$1000.00

\$400.00 non-refundable deposit, \$600.00 at least one week before the wedding – includes using chapel for rehearsal. Chapel Banners will be removed by authorized chapel personnel.

Please read and review carefully the *Building Use Agreement* for additional chapel stipulations. Please share regulations with your florist, decorators, and wedding party so everyone is aware of the guidelines.

Caretaker is present at reception and wedding.

Use of the chapel annex, which includes a unisex rest room. Food is allowed in the Annex. **NO** Food is allowed in the Chapel.

Arrangements can be made for you to decorate the Chapel.

Seats approximately 200 people : 34 pews x 5 people = 175 34 pews x 6 people = 204

No receptions are allowed on chapel grounds.

You must have your own minister.

Rehearsals must be at or after 6:00pm and last no more than 1 hour.

No colored flower petals can be thrown into the aisle; white petals are allowed.
