**General Rules and Regulations**

**Revised 2-8-18**

1. All minors are to be supervised at all times. Tennant shall be responsible for all persons in the building or adjacent grounds.
2. Dance wax, cornstarch, birdseed, confetti, glitter, rice, straw, sand, bubbles, fog, smoke and similar materials are not allowed. If used, damage fees will be charged.
3. No open Flame. Sterno is acceptable when used for warming food.
4. No animals, excluding service dogs are allowed in the Exhibit Building or Convention Center.
5. Tables and chairs may not be removed from any building.
6. Tenant is responsible for setting up and tearing down tables / chairs and stacking on storage carts.
7. Tables and chairs must be cleaned before placing on storage racks.
8. Do not allow tables, chairs or other equipment to be dragged across the floor.
9. Free standing decorations are permitted as long as they do not block exits. Decorations may only be placed on metal walls by using 3M Command strips. Decorations may be hung from the ceiling by using approved magnetic hooks only you may rent approved hooks from the fairgrounds. Hook must be attached where grid sections intersect and must be a minimum of 4 ft apart. The weight limit per hook is 15 pounds. Do not hang objects from sprinkler heads. Tape or nails are not permitted.
10. 3M Painters Tape may be used for marking floors for booth spaces.
11. Delivery or Catering vehicles are not permitted on the Exhibit Hall porch.
12. There is no smoking permitted inside any buildings. Violations of this rule will result in forfeiture of the deposit.
13. The building will be subject to inspection at any time by any Gibson County Fair Board Member.
14. The tenant shall be liable for all damage or loss to property resulting from occupancy and use of the buildings and/or grounds, other than normal wear and tear.
15. The tenant shall not remove, alter, adjust or otherwise change any light fixtures or light bulbs.
16. There is no cooking permitted in any of the facility's kitchens.
17. Any group charging a fee to the public must obtain a permit or license from Homeland. Security
18. Selling of food items requires a permit from the Gibson County Health Department.
19. The number of persons in a building shall not exceed the posted number.
20. Reset thermostats to 72 degrees when leaving building.
21. Verify all doors are locked.
