Rev. Patrick's Couple/Officiant Collaboration: An Action Plan for Success

If you are looking for an elegant, warm-hearted and uplifting Wedding Ceremony that inspires smiles and sets the right tone for your Big Moment, Rev Patrick can help you make that wish a happy reality.

Here's how to begin collaborating with Rev. Pat to design Your Day, Your Way:

1. Set up your first Rev Pat - Couple Discussion. A Zoom call of 40 minutes will help ensure a good fit, and begin to unleash creativity. We will discuss your vision, and take note of things you want, and others you wish to avoid. We will get a sense of the tone of the event, and preferred approaches for working together in a positive, respectful and purposeful way.

2. Confirm Your Booking* by submitting a 50% retainer fee via Interac e-Transfer to <u>RevPBK@cogeco.ca</u>. The balance is due one month before your Wedding Day.

3. Read the Officiant Agreement, and submit your Couple's Ceremony Intake and Love Story Notes.

4. Discuss your preferences for designing a Personalized Wedding Ceremony — Your Way:

- A. Procession
- B. Welcome Message Story about Couple's Love; Reading
- C. Consent and Intent (Legally Required)
- D. Affirmation of Witnesses
- E. Exchange of Vows
- F. Exchange of Rings
- G. Signing of Marriage Licence and Marriage Register (Legally Required)
- H. Closing Statements
- I. Declaration of Marriage (Legally Required)
- J. Sealed with A Kiss
- K. Recessional

Note: There are a few legally required elements, but there is plenty of opportunity for you to customize the Ceremony <u>your way</u> with the help of Rev Patrick.

5. Rev Patrick will provide you with information on how to obtain your Marriage Licence and a Marriage Certificate*. (*Visit <u>https://www.ontario.ca/page/getting-married</u>) He will provide your personal Ceremony Plan, Ceremony Script, and Ceremony Rehearsal Checklist.

6. Be sure to *do everything with love*, and make sure it makes you both happy. Your IWedding Ceremony is a Celebration of Love— Your Love. As your Licensed Marriage Officiant, Rev Patrick will help you shape it "your way."
