# TIME! Birthday Party Package FAQ's

1. Is The Slime Lab open to the public during my party?
Yes! The Slime Lab is a museum open to the public during regular hours,
even while parties are in session. Don't worry — your dedicated party host
(Slimeologist) will guide your group through exhibits and slime-making
activities, keeping your party together at all times.

2. Can we bring outside food and drinks?
Yes! You're welcome to bring your own catering, snacks, and cake/cupcakes for your quests to enjoy.

3. How early can we arrive?

You'll have access to your party room 10 minutes before your start time. Our team will set up any decorations you bring (banners, centerpieces, goodie bags, themed tablecloths, etc.) while your party enjoys the Slime Lab. Please make sure these items are pre-assembled for easy placement.

4. Can we bring ice cream or ice cream cake?

Sorry — we don't have freezer storage available for these items.

## 5. Can we BYOB?

BYOB is only permitted for corporate team outings. Food and drinks must stay in the party room at all times.

6. Is there a place for presents?

Yes! We set up two tables that can be used for presents, cake/cupcakes, goodie bags, paper goods, and more.

7. What is your cancellation policy?

We offer party credits (no expiration) that you can use for a future visit.

Refunds are not provided.

8. Does the birthday child count as a sliming guest? Yes — the birthday star counts as one sliming guest.

9. Are children under 1 free?

We leave this up to the host and the child's parents. If they'd like their toddler to make slime, they count as a sliming guest. Otherwise, ages 1 and under may enjoy our free sensory play without charge.

10. Is there a minimum age?

We recommend slime creations for ages 3 and up. Younger guests often enjoy slime sensory play, especially if they've used slime or playdough pefore. For groups with children 5 and under, we suggest our least sticky textures for the best experience.

11. How do I get my digital invitations?

Once you book your party, your confirmation email will include instructions on how to request your digital invites.

12. I've got my RSVPs — now what?

Five days before your party, our team will email you to check in on your guest count. Don't worry — you only pay for the extra sliming guests who actually attend, and guests can be added last-minute. Knowing your headcount just helps us set up your party room.

## 13. How much do I need to reserve?

Reserve your Slime Lab party with a \$174.50 deposit through our online booking system (with live availability). The remaining balance, including any additional sliming guests, is due on the day of your party.

# 14. What's the schedule of the party?

60 mins in the Slime Lab:

20-25 mins sensory play in exhibits (walk on slime + giant bubble)
30 mins custom slime-making (choose from 9 textures, colors, scents,
100+ toppings & charms)

Birthday photo op in slime booth + inside a giant slime bubble 45 mins in private party room for food & celebration

# 15. What is a dedicated email chat?

This simply means you can email us anytime with questions before your event. Just reach out to info@theslimelabco.com and we'll be happy to help.

16. Can guests access the Slime Lab after the party room?

Due to capacity limits, guests cannot re-enter the exhibits after your party room time.

17. Do you serve pizzas or cake?

Our team doesn't serve food — the party room is yours to enjoy privately with your guests. If you have a large group, you may ask your party host to assist with pizza serving, and they'll be glad to help!
