

Payments

- Initial payment is due NO LATER THAN 5 days after contract being signed. Contract can be signed electronically. If mailing, payments accepted in the form of check from local bank. Payments can also be made in cash or by credit card. Contact us and we will make arrangements to meet with you.
- Final payment is usually due no later than 10 days prior to the event date.

Inclement Weather Policy: It is understood that if this is a "Rain or Shine" event, the DJ's compensation is in no way affected by inclement weather:

- For Outdoor or Tent events, in addition to the electrical requirements mentioned above, the client and/or their agents must provide the DJ with complete protection from all weather related elements such as, but not limited to: wind; water (from overhead, underneath, and all sides); & direct sunlight.
- Access to the electrical source must also be in a safe location not impacted by water. The DJ reserves the right, in good faith, to stop or cancel performance should weather pose a potential danger to him, the equipment, or audience. This includes high winds and / or proximity of lightning. Every effort will be made to continue the performance; however, safety is paramount at all times and in all decisions. The DJ's compensation will not be affected by such cancellation.

Venue Policy:

Access to the venue is required **no less than 90 minutes prior** to the scheduled start time for the event to allow time for proper setup of any and all equipment provided by the DJ to properly serve the event. Access to the venue is required for **no less than 60 minutes following** the event to allow for proper packing and removal of any and all equipment provided by the DJ to properly serve the event. Any fees required by the venue to make sure the above access times are provided will be the responsibility of the client. Such fees will not be the responsibility of the DJ.

Photography / Video Policy:

Client gives the DJ and his staff permission to take photos before and during the event for their sole use. Photographs or video taken will not be available for sale.

Rights to Cancellation:

- This contract cannot be cancelled except by mutual written consent of both the client and the DJ.
- In the event the DJ cancels the performance the client shall be refunded all retainer fees and payments in full. Should DJ become seriously ill; injured; suffer catastrophic equipment loss; death of a parent, spouse, sibling, or child; or other extraordinary Acts of God; nature or fate; the DJ agrees to take prudent actions to provide client approved alternative choice or the client may accept refund of all payments paid to DJ, less costs of time and material expenditures for event.
- If cancellation is not initiated by the client in writing, at least 90 days prior to the event, the DJ is entitled to the non-refundable retainer fee and any payments already made in good faith..

Additional:

- The Client shall take all steps necessary to protect the DJ's equipment, music and personnel during the contracted period. Any damages incurred due to lack of reasonable protection on the client's part, except in the case of gross negligence on the part of the DJ, shall be payable by the client to the extent of repair or replacement of damaged equipment and music, and all cost of medical treatment.
- In the event of circumstances deemed to present a threat, danger, or implied threat of injury or harm to the DJ or any equipment in the DJ's possession, the DJ reserves the right to cease performance. If the client is able to resolve the threatening situation in a reasonable amount of time (maximum of 15 minutes), the DJ shall resume performance in accordance with original terms of this agreement. Client shall be responsible for payment in full regardless of whether the situation is resolved & the DJ resumes performance of the remainder of services is cancelled as a result of disruption.
- In order to prevent equipment damage or liability arising from accidental injury to any individual attending this performance the DJ reserves the right to deny any person(s) access to the sound system, music recordings, other equipment, or general area designated for the DJ.
- The client and/or client's agent(s) must provide one 115 volt 20 amp duplex grounded electrical outlet, the circuit being free of any other electrical devices, and be located / positioned within 15 feet of the DJ's setup area. All client and/or provided extension cords must be minimally: 3 conductor, 14

gauge wire not to exceed 25 feet in length, and be safely installed, attached, and secured in advance of DJ's arrival.

- Travel: 50 cent a mile for any distance greater than 50 miles beyond North Charleston.
- Any late night event greater than 90 minutes from North Charleston weill incur overnight hotel fees.Ceremony music: \$150 (Ceremony must be at same location as reception site)
